

WARNING FOR TOWN OF STAMFORD

The legal voters of the Town of Stamford, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Stamford Community Room in Stamford Elementary School at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, August 22, 2022, to vote on the Articles of the Town Warrant. The meeting will then be adjourned until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 23, 2022 at the Stamford Community Room at which time Article 2 will be transacted by ballot.

Vermont law imposes requirements to ensure that elderly and disabled persons have access to polling places and town meeting. Individuals requesting alternative accommodations should contact the town clerk's office prior to the town meeting so that arrangements can be made in advance.

Article 1: Shall the Town of Stamford vote to assess the local option tax allowed by the state (currently it is one (1) percent), on sales, meals and alcoholic beverages, and rooms pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 138(b) if the town is determined to be eligible?

Article 2: Shall the Town of Stamford authorize cannabis retailers and retail portions of integrated licensee establishments in town pursuant to 7 V.S.A. § 863?


